WORKSHOP AND EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

Saturday June 8

11:00: **Blues 101** – Ryan and the boys deliver a master class on basics of the blues, including the history, the music and the players and the surprising connections to bluegrass music.

12:00: **Making Sense of Old Time, Country and Bluegrass** – Three kissing cousins meet up for an hour for a heart to heart about why they're different but also the same.

12:00 – **Kid's Beginner Fiddle** – If you've never played the fiddle before but would like to try, or are just getting going, this workshop is for you.

1:00: **Showcase Stage Band Competition** – Get your group together and come play a 15-minute set with professional adjudication. The winners are guaranteed a spot at the 2020 Festival. The Showcase will be topped off by a Cajun music set performed by Brigitte Desjardins and Sarah Hamilton.
